2018-2019 School Year Agricultural Scholarship

MSPC will make scholarships available to any junior and/or senior regardless of where they are going to college in Michigan as long as they are going into an ag related field and their family pays into the soybean checkoff. One award of \$2,000 will be made to a senior and one \$1,500 award will be made to a junior (class levels determined as of Fall 2018 semester) that submit this application and supporting documents by the deadline. Recipient selection will be made by the MSPC office, based on the following criteria:

1. Student must be a graduate of a Michigan high school, pursuing a four-year degree in a soybean-related field (Agronomy, Agribusiness, Nutrition, etc.) at an accredited institution (may be out-of-state).
2. Student must maintain a full course load (minimum of 12 credits) and a 3.0 GPA or higher on a four-point scale.
3. Student must submit this form completed in its entirety, along with:
 - a. Two letters of recommendation from teachers and/or employers
 - b. Official academic transcript
 - c. Personal Essay
 - d. High-resolution photo.

All materials must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 20, 2018.
