



*The Green Fair Project is an application 50% reimbursement for fairs who include agriculture in their programs. Each qualifying fair is reimbursable 50% up to \$5,000.*

*Example: If the fair needs a new roof and uses soy products, and the roof cost \$10,000, the grant would be \$5,000. But if the roof cost \$12,000 the grant would still only be \$5,000. If the roof cost \$8,000 the grant would be \$4,000.*
